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ELMO Forms

Installation and configuration

The plugin embeds ELMO signup forms on WordPress/WooCommerce sites. Version 1.0.0, files: `cszd-forms.php`, `cszd-mail.php`, `cszd-support.php`.

Installation

1. Upload the plugin directory to `wp-content/plugins/`.
2. Activate it under *Plugins* → *Installed Plugins*.
3. Go to *Settings* → *ELMO Forms*.

Configuration

Field	Description
Base URL	Address of your ELMO instance, e.g. <code>https://elmo.piotrlitwa.com</code> . Stored without a trailing slash.
API Key	Key from the ELMO panel, format <code>cszd_xxxxxxxx...</code> .

Without both values the forms will not render.

Shortcode [elmo_form]

Basic usage — `uuid` is the only required attribute:

```
[elmo_form uuid="your-uuid"]
```

Without `uuid` the plugin renders a red error message instead of the form.

Attributes

Attribute	Default	Description
<code>uuid</code>	—	Required. Form identifier in ELMO.
<code>height</code>	<code>400</code>	Height in pixels.
<code>width</code>	<code>100%</code>	Width — pixels or percentage.
<code>mode</code>	<code>iframe</code>	<code>iframe</code> or <code>native</code> .
<code>title</code>	empty	Overrides the title coming from ELMO.
<code>subtitle</code>	empty	Overrides the subtitle coming from ELMO.

Example

```
[elmo_form uuid="a1b2c3" mode="native" height="520" title="Sign up"]
```

Besides the shortcode, the plugin provides a widget and a Gutenberg block.

Thank-you page

A separate form appended to the WooCommerce thank-you page — typically a newsletter signup in exchange for a coupon. Configured under *Settings* → *ELMO Forms*.

Option	Default
<code>elmo_forms_thankyou_uuid</code>	empty — without it the section will not appear
<code>elmo_forms_thankyou_title</code>	"Dolacz do newslettera!"
<code>elmo_forms_thankyou_subtitle</code>	"Odbierz kupon rabatowy na nastepne zakupy."

Title and subtitle override whatever comes from ELMO.
